Development Education Workshops for Second Level Students 2009/10

WorldWise, the Irish Aid Schools Linking and Immersion Scheme, together with **IDEA**, the Irish Development Education Association, has developed a suite of three development education workshops for second-level students involved in school partnership projects:

Workshop 1: Development and School Linking

Workshop 2: Setting a Global Context for Linking

Workshop 3: Country/Issue specific session

From September 2009, these workshops will be available to second-level schools and will be facilitated by IDEA members throughout the country (see details overleaf).

The aims of the workshop suite are to:

- examine the term ‘development’ from different perspectives
- answer the question “Why Linking?”
- set a global context for school partnerships
- provide an issue/country-specific workshop



The workshops are designed to be run as a suite of three but different workshops may be delivered by different organisations. The cost per workshop will be around €120 and each one will run for about two hours. WorldWise schools may use part of their Project Grants to pay for these workshops.
